Individuals or groups are welcome to appear as a delegation to express their concerns, provide comments or ask questions on any matter within the mandate of the Board or Committee. In accordance with the Board's bylaws, delegations shall be permitted up to four (4) minutes to address the Board where the delegation has provided a written submission no later than 4:00 p.m. on the Thursday prior to the meeting. Delegations registering after the cutoff shall be granted two (2) minutes. All interested delegates must complete and submit the following form.

Once you have submitted your request, a member of the Board Services team will be in touch with you to confirm the delegation and provide the necessary meeting details and instructions.

I would like to REGISTER TO BECOME A DELEGATE and to speak about unacceptable political events, flyers, signs, fake information, and antisemitism at the OCDSB schools/school areas.

OCDSB didn't approve any of these events/actions, but they continue to do it regularly inside of OCDSB properties. These illegal events were mostly organized by (palestinian youth movement of Ottawa, see pictures below).

They even say "Let's show the OCDSB they can't shut down and censor palestine in school anymore", which means they know that they do illegal actions against OCDSB policy but they do it inside of school anyway !!! See the picture below.

Schools must be out of politics/political events and must follow Canadian Government Canadian policy and political decisions.

Just an example: If some underage student comes to school with the sight "palestine from the river to sea", means that he calls to destroy Israel and to "disappear" all Jewish that live in Israel.

Our family and many other families started to discuss taking our kids out of OCDSB schools and even leaving Canada.

We don't feel safe and OCDSB doesn't do anything to take all political events outside of school and protect our kids.

I can forward you my email conversations with the [REDACTED] principal (OCDSB management representatives were added to CC or BCC) and pictures of illegal flyers (that were on the walls inside of [REDACTED] school) and pictures from social media
