## **Project Committee**

Central staff meets monthly to guide the work and bring Districtwide perspectives on the process

## One-to-One Conversations

Trustees and senior staff will hold authentic, personal conversations with the community to understand their priorities

### How?

Participants sign up for virtual or inperson chats

## When?

December 2022 -January 2023

## Small Group Conversations

Building on established relationships, advisory committees and student groups will have an opportunity for indepth conversation

#### How?

Using a prepared toolkit during scheduled meeting time

#### When?

December 2022-February 2023

## **Public Gatherings**

Larger scale
conversations are
designed for listening
and building
connections.

#### How?

The community is invited to meet and share experiences and perspectives with system leaders at a special event

## When?

January 12: Ottawa
Technical SS
January 19: Bell HS
February 2: Virtual

## **Online Conversations**

There will be an opportunity to provide voice and share insights in an online format, and to learn from others.

#### How?

Participants share thoughts anonymously, in their language of choice, at a time convenient for them

## When?

Over a two-week period, mid-late January 2023

## **Trustee Leadership**

Trustees will play an active role in each component of the consultation, which will allow them to use what they hear and learn to inform the development of the strategic plan.

## **Collaborative Plan Development**

Informed by the consultation and environmental scan, Trustees and staff will build a plan that reflects the needs and priorities of the community, by April 2023.
