During the on-line phase, my daughter saw her kindergarten teachers for 15 minutes every 2 weeks (7.5 minutes each week). I'm wondering if any education specialist would define that as teacher-led, on-line learning.

Given the report that private schools carried out on-line learning throughout the regular school day (CBC article of June 24, and the schools' websites), will the Board require teachers from kindergarten up to teach their full-day of school, in the event of on-line learning? This is so that a situation is not created whereby students in the private system receive a consistent teacher-led education this year while those in the public system do not).
