Summary of main points for the issue/ concern:

1. Due to the number (lack) of gender neutral washrooms in elementary schools, policies are required to ensure that trans non-binary students have access to these washrooms and needing to choose a gendered washrooms causes undue stress.
2. Running events at the elementary level should be open, and not gendered. It places undue stress on trans kids to need to choose a binary category in which to compete.

Recommendation(s) for resolution of issue:

1. School board wide directive on the accessibility of all gender washrooms for students.
2. move to removed gendered categories from elementary running competition as done in other school boards.
