Brief summary of issue or topic of discussion:

I have many reasons why I need to avoid catching covid. The in-person schools no longer have covid precautions in place. I am not alone. Many of my peers also have medical needs and/or educational needs that mean that OCV is a better place for them than an in-person school. We do not want our school to close. It is important that it be properly funded and made into a permanent school.
