TITLE: GUIDELINES FOR DEALING WITH REPORTS OF STRANGERS

APPROACHING STUDENTS

1.0 OBJECTIVE

To ensure that the Board provides a safe environment and responds in a timely and effective manner when a child is approached by a stranger in and around schools.

2.0 POLICY

- 2.1 In ensuring the safety of students, the Board shall:
 - a) maintain appropriate supervision in all schools and at school-sponsored events;
 - b) support a comprehensive personal safety curriculum from primary to intermediate grades; and
 - c) maintain a close working relationship with the Ottawa-Carleton Regional Police and the Ontario Provincial Police.
