<p>Improve students' literacy learning and achievement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• % of students who meet or exceed the provincial standard on Grade 3 and 6 EQAO reading and writing</li> <li>• % of fully participating, first-time eligible students who are successful on the OSSLT</li> </ul>
<p>Improve students' math learning and achievement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• % of students who meet or exceed the provincial standard on Grade 3, 6, and 9 EQAO math</li> </ul>
<p>Improve students' graduation rates and preparedness for future success</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• % of students who earn 16 or more credits by the end of Grade 10</li> <li>• % of students participating in at least one job skills program (SHSM, Dual Credit, OYAP)</li> <li>• % of students graduating with an OSSD within five years of starting Grade 9</li> <li>• % of students enrolled in at least one Grade 12 math or Grade 11 or 12 Science course</li> <li>• % of students who believe their learning has prepared them for the next step in their learning experience (i.e. next grade, post-secondary, etc.)</li> </ul>
<p>Improve students' participation in class time and learning</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• % of students in Grades 1-8 whose individual attendance rate is equal to or greater than 90%</li> <li>• % of students in Grades 4-12 who were suspended at least once</li> </ul>
<p>Improve student well-being</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• % of Grade 6, 9, and 10 students who report being aware of mental health supports and services in order to seek supports for mental health</li> </ul>
