RE: Minor Housekeeping Policy Edits(Tier 1)

On 31 May 2022, the Board approved revisions to [Policy P 001 GOV - Policy Development and Management](#), which included the delegation of authority to the Director of Education for minor revisions (known as Tier 1 Policy Review) to policies (section 3.3) that do not alter any substantive provision, term, intent, or right contained within a policy.

Minor revisions (Tier 1) specifically include:

- correcting inconsistencies;
- modernizing and using gender-neutral language;
- harmonizing definitions;
- establishing consistency in reference to spelling, capitalization, and punctuation;
- revisions to ensure alignment with, and references to language in statutes, regulations, policy memorandums, or other regulatory directives, and/or
- inserting, adding, or deleting reference documents.

In accordance with Policy P 001 GOV - Policy Development and Management, the following policies fall under the purview of Tier 1 revisions and have been amended as set out below.

P 098 CUR - Equity and Inclusive Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Updating language in the ‘Rationale’ to align more closely with the governing PPM 119
P 125 SCO - School District Code of Conduct	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● S. 5.8 - Removing the reference to a procedure planned to be a part of a safe schools procedure merger, which would result in its rescission

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● S. 5.21 - Removing this clause as the weapons procedure is planned to be rescinded ● Removing the Reference Documents that have been rescinded
P 138 CUR - Environmental Education	<p>In response to concerns around Tier 1 revisions in November 2024, 3.3 and 4.2 have reverted to the original language, including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● S. 3.3 - “develop the knowledge and skills they need to”; and ● S. 4.2 - “and the natural world”

It is worth noting that the authorization to the Director of Education to make minor revisions to a policy does not preclude the Board from recommending future Tier 2 or 3 reviews within the five-year policy review cycle.
